The Contra Costa County Office of Education is committed to supporting College and Career Readiness (CCR) for all students in Contra Costa County. The CCR department helps coordinate Career Technical Education (CTE) programs at school districts through the Regional Occupational Program (ROP). Support includes funding of ROP classes, articulation with community colleges, alignment to UC/CSU 'a-g' requirements, workbased learning opportunities, teacher credential assistance, and much more.



ROP is funded by CTEIG, KI2 SWP and local funds

ROP/CTE

Offers more than 90 standards-based courses within the 15 stateidentified Career Technical Education (CTE) industry sectors. Includes nearly 70 ROP courses that are UC 'a-g' approved (the most of any ROP in the state). *10,000 students at nearly 30 High Schools.
